




## Windows XP


### Applying compatibility settings to an installed game:

**Step 1.** Find the program shortcut in your Start Menu, All Programs sub-menu.



**Step 2.** Highlight it (as in the example of I Spy Junior in the screenshot above) and right-click on it, selecting Properties from the menu that pops up.

**Step 3.** Now select the Compatibility tab.



**Step 4.** Select Windows 95 or Windows 98 (if your game was originally designed to work on Windows 3.1 or Windows 95 always choose this). Tick all options as per the System Requirements of your game, tick Disable Visual Themes, click on Apply and then OK. If you forget to click on Apply it won't save the settings and nothing will change.

The most important thing to remember is that you **MUST** start the game using that shortcut at all times, or the compatibility settings will not be applied & you will continue having the same problems. If a window pops up when you insert the cd-rom (whether physically or virtually through Daemon Tools), please close them, then use the shortcut to play the game.

We highly recommend you send a copy of the game's shortcut to the desktop for your convenience. Check that the compatibility settings have come across with it by right-clicking on it, selecting Properties and then the Compatibility Tab. If the settings are not there please repeat the instructions from Step 4 to apply them.
