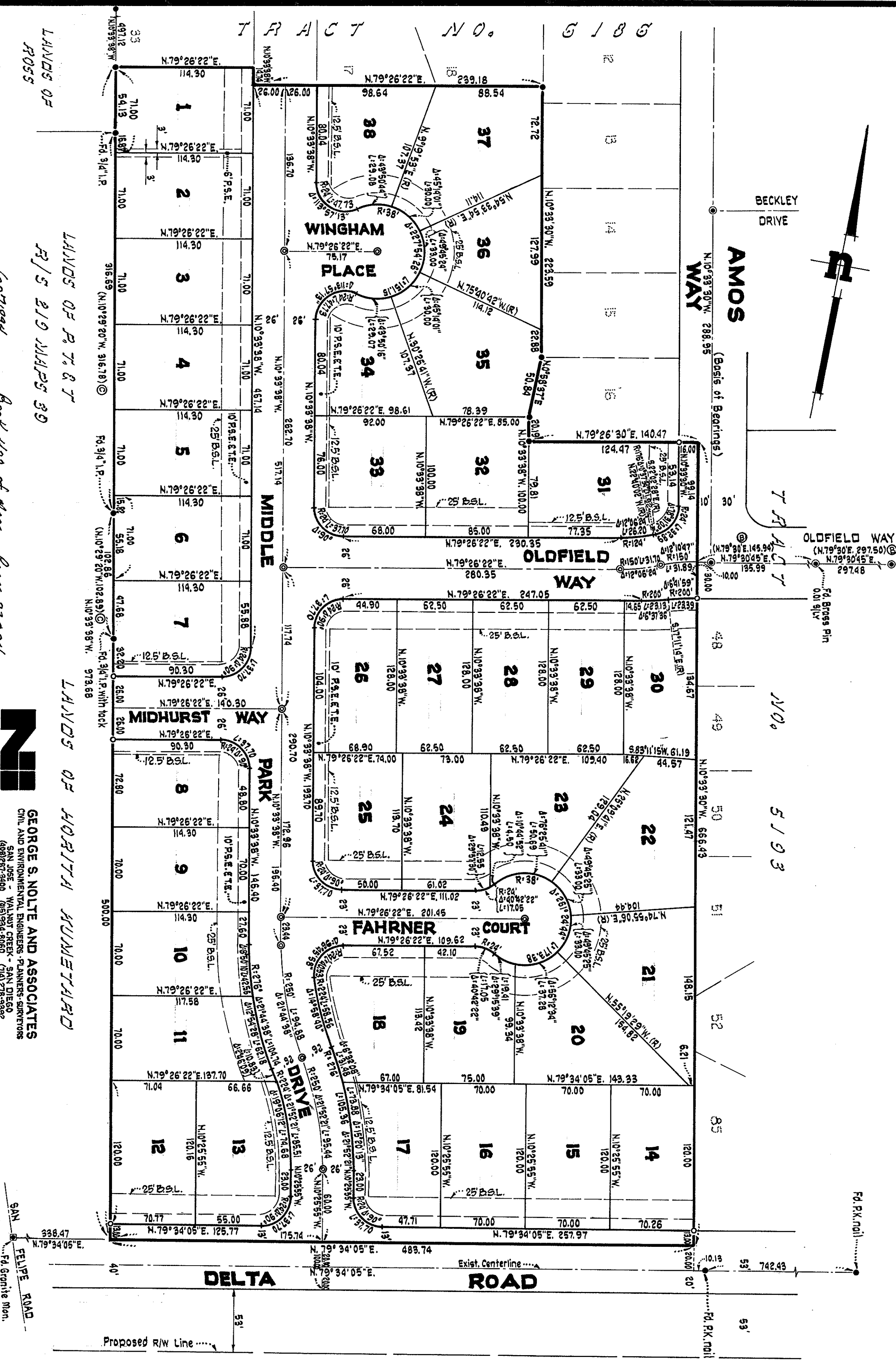
BEING A PORTION OF THE RANCHO YERBA BUENA Y SOCAYRE
