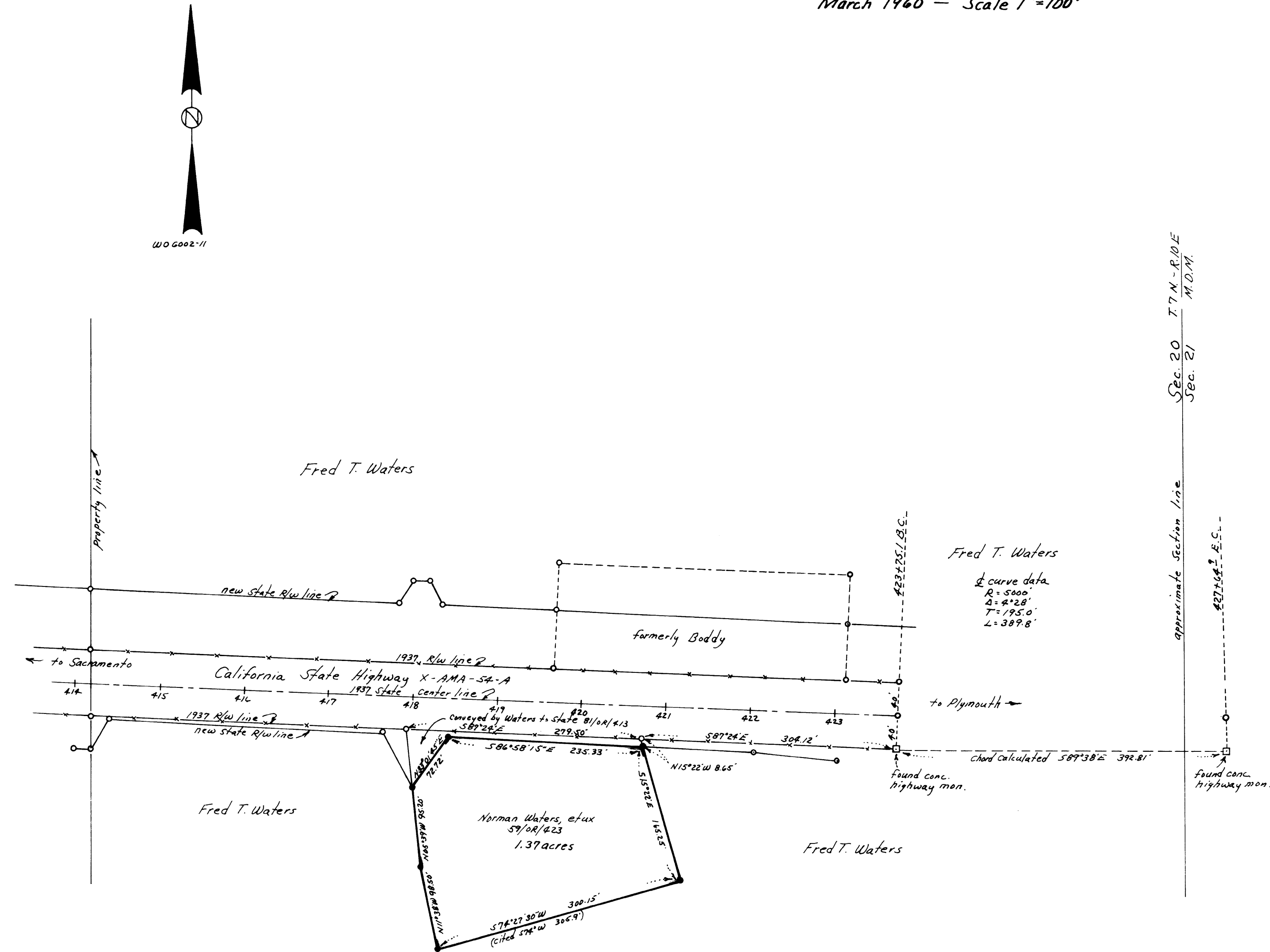


RECORD OF SURVEY

 - The meridian of this survey is identical with the meridian of the California State 1937 survey of Highway X-AMA-54-A.
 - This is a re-tracement survey of a parcel of land described in a deed recorded in the office of the Recorder of Amador County in Book 59 of Official Records at page 423; said deed fails to mathematically close by 3.74' in lat. and 4.92' in departure. The parcel of land as monumented and delineated upon this survey forms a mathematically closed figure. This closure was accomplished by an adjustment in the South boundary line.
