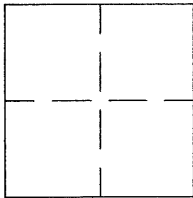

A description of the physical condition of the monument as found and as set or reset: FOUR NAIL SPREADERS SET AT A DISTANCE OF 4 FEET FROM EACH OTHER WERE SET TO DEFINE THE POSITION OF THE ORIGINAL MONUMENT. A STANDARD MONUMENT WELL WAS SET AND A STANDARD ALAMEDA COUNTY MONUMENT DISK STAMPED "SMA-PRI 2003" WAS SET ON TOP OF THE MONUMENT WELL POST. THIS WAS TO REPLACE THE THE DESTROYED MONUMENT DESCRIBED IN CR-1551.
